

Current Bylaw in effect:

ARTICLE V - EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

SECTION 1 MEMBERS

- A. The Executive Committee shall be composed of the officers, the MCCC Director, one Division of Continuing Education (hereinafter DCE) at large unit member, and others as named by the BrCCC President.
- B. The at large DCE member shall serve a two (2) year term of office and may stand for reelection. Election of the at large member should take place in April or May and may be held at the same time as the election of officers.

SECTION 2 POWERS AND DUTIES

Within the BrCCC Bylaws and policies approved by the membership, the Executive Committee shall be responsible for the management of the BrCCC. It shall have the authority and responsibility to do the following:

- A. adopt procedures and rules for conducting the business of the BrCCC;
- B. appoint coordinators as needed to carry out the business of the BrCCC and the MCCC;
- C. receive and act upon reports and recommendations from committees;
- D. recommend policies or changes of policy to the membership;
- E. implement changes of policy approved by the membership;
- F. adopt an annual budget for the operation of the BrCCC;
- G. employ staff as needed for the efficient management of the BrCCC.

ARTICLE V - EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Section 1 Members

The Executive Committee shall be composed of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Director, Adjunct DCE Representative, and Professional Staff Representative. These are the only voting members of the Executive Committee.

Section 2 Powers and Duties

Within the BrCCC Bylaws and policies approved by the membership, the Executive Committee shall be responsible for the management of the BrCCC. It shall have the authority and responsibility to do the following:

- A. adopt procedures and rules for conducting the business of the BrCCC;
- B. be the first to receive and act upon reports and recommendations from committees;
- C. provide input to the President for development of agendas for Executive Committee and membership meetings;
- D. recommend bylaws and policies or changes of policy to the membership;
- E. implement changes of bylaw and policy approved by the membership;
- F. recommend an annual budget for the operation of the BrCCC to the members for adoption;
- G. employ staff as needed for the efficient management of the BrCCC.
- H. organize, engage in outreach, and plan union activities for the BCC campus
- I. encourage member participation in all union activities

Article V - EXECUTIVE COMMITTEES

Section 1 Membership

The Executive Committee of the MCCC Bristol Community Chapter shall consist of elected officials, and appointed Standing Committee members as follows: MCCC Director, President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Adjunct DCE Representative, Professional Staff Representative, Day Grievance Coordinator, DCE Grievance Coordinator, Strategic Action Coordinator, and Membership Chair. Additionally, three Presidential appointed members from the MACER may also serve. All committee members have full voting privileges on Committee business.

Section 2 Powers and Duties

Within the BrCCC Bylaws and policies approved by the membership, the Executive Committee shall be responsible for the management of the BrCCC. It shall have the authority and responsibility to do the following:

- A. adopt procedures and rules for conducting the business of the BrCCC;
- B. be the first to receive and act upon reports and recommendations from committees;

ARTICLE V - EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

Section 1 Members

- A. The Executive Committee shall be composed of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Director. Others may be invited to the Executive Committee by the President as needed.
- B. In accordance with Article IV, Section 6. A., in the event that the elected Executive Committee members do not include representation from a demographic (eg. full time faculty, part-time faculty, professional staff), then the President is compelled to appoint (with the approval of the rest of the Executive Committee) an At-Large Member to serve on the Executive Committee. This/these appointee(s) has/have full voting rights at any time a vote is needed.

Section 2 Powers and Duties
