Dear MCCC member:

We have been fighting for health care for all MCCC-represented community college employees for years now—at the bargaining table, in the legislature, and even in the courts. One of the cornerstones of the Cherish Act is to achieve equity in pay and benefits throughout all of public higher ed. Many of our colleagues who are un-insured or under-insured have come forward to testify at legislative hearings, and sharing those stories has raised the awareness of legislators about this problem.

<u>Today</u> we are faced with a health care emergency, and we are demanding emergency action by the Governor and the legislature.

Senator Gobi has filed legislation that would immediately extend health care to adjuncts, so it's more important than ever to raise our voices and concerns to representatives and help build the momentum that will push this through. We are going to need robust, member-driven action in order to win emergency healthcare.

The federal CARES Act allocates millions of dollars for higher education, including funding that is at the Governor's discretion to spend on addressing the COVID-19 crisis in Massachusetts.

Will you join us in taking action to demand emergency health care coverage for adjuncts?

There are two ways you can help:
