

Calling All MTA Members -- preK - Higher Ed for a Special Membership Meeting

This year has been a year like no other. And the coming school year will be a school year like no other. Educators, families, and students across the state are increasingly anxious about returning to school and colleges in just a few weeks. The MTA, local leaders and the rank and file have filled the vacuum left by a lack of leadership from the state campus leaders, and local districts. We've been acting collectively to endorse a thoughtful plan for resuming learning in the fall. But there is much more to do. As a union of educators, we must continue to stand together – for ourselves, our students, our families, our communities – and face the difficult choice before us.

We all want nothing more than to be back in the classrooms, face to face with our students – that is how education is supposed to take place. But we know that many buildings are not safe and that community public health benchmarks are not yet established or clear. That is why the MTA Board of Directors has taken the position that we will resume learning in the safest way possible and return to buildings only when it is safe.

We are at a critical turning point and that is why we are taking an exciting and extraordinary step of calling a statewide membership meeting. At the meeting we will review the details of changes in DESE guidelines from 180 to 170 days that was won through all of your collective action and the statewide campaign for higher ed that has just been launched -- and will hear from health and safety experts, MTA local leaders from across the state, take a poll of the membership on the critical position of how to resume learning in the fall, and plan collective actions to win the schools and colleges our communities deserve during the pandemic.

Your confirmation will contain the information on how to join the July 29 meeting. Do not forward your meeting link to anyone else. Each attendee must register and then receive their unique meeting link. In addition, for security reasons, because these meetings are designed for MTA members only, phone dial-in will NOT be enabled for this meeting. You must join the meeting via the Zoom link provided in your confirmation email. You may join from a computer, smartphone, or tablet. From a PC or Mac, when clicking on your "Join" link, you will be prompted to download and install the Zoom app when joining your FIRST Zoom meeting on that device.
