It has been a busy month as BrCCC members of have been participating in collaborative efforts advocating for full funding for our system of public higher education:

- The rally for Public Higher Education at Bristol Community College, Wednesday, August 19th This event was part of larger statewide day of action calling for <u>Full</u> <u>Funding of Our Public Colleges, No Layoffs and Safe Reopening Strategies.</u> About 35 people participated in the rally, which included faculty, staff, and alumni from Bristol CC, UMass Dartmouth, Bridgewater State, and Massasoit.
